AN ACT Relating to Requests for Information from Filing Officer Under the Uniform Commercial Code.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 11, § 9-407, sub-§ (2), repealed and replaced. Subsection (2) of section 9-407 of Title 11 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

“(2) Upon request of any person, the filing officer shall issue his certificate showing whether there is on file, on the date and hour stated therein, any presently effective financing statement naming a particular debtor and any continuation statement, termination statement, statement of assignment or statement of release or amendment thereof; and, if there is, given the date and hour of filing of each such statement and the names and addresses of each secured party named therein. The fee for such a certificate shall be \$2.

Upon request the filing officer shall furnish a copy of any filed financing statement, continuation statement, termination statement, statement of assignment or statement of release or amendment thereof for a fee of \$1, and, if such statement consists of more than 3 pages, an additional fee of 50c for the 4th and each succeeding page. The filing officer may answer telephone inquiries at a fee of not less than \$3 for each debtor search.”
