SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 964, L. D. 1299, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to Licensing of Embalmers, Funeral Directors and  
Funeral Homes."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the 3rd underlined sentence  
of that part designated "§1504." of section 3 the following under-  
lined sentences:

'Any person holding an embalmer's license or a funeral director's  
license issued under this or any other law, may, when not actively  
engaged in the profession of embalming and funeral directing, request  
the Board of Examiners of Funeral Directors and Embalmers to hold  
said licenses in a nonactive or dormant status without cost to the  
petitioner. Petitioner may, upon future request, have said licenses  
reactivated by paying the required fee for the current year.'
