STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Definition of Part-Time Class A Restaurant Under Liquor Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 2, sub-§ 18, amended. The 3rd sentence of subsection 18 of section 2 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Part-time licensees must do a minimum of \$30,000 \$15,000 business in sale or service of food to the public on their premises.'
