**AN ACT Relating to Grouping of Certain School Administrative Units.**

---

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 20, § 151, sub-§ 1, amended.** Subsection 1 of section 151 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'1. **Existing unions with over 35 teachers and salary of superintendent over \$9,500.** Existing supervisory unions employing over 35 teachers and paying the superintendent of schools an annual salary of over ~~\$4,500~~ **\$9,500** shall not be regrouped unless the proposed regrouping shall have first been approved by a majority of the school committee members in the administrative units involved.'
