STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Grouping of Certain School Administrative Units.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 20, § 151, sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 151 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- '1. Existing unions with over 35 teachers and salary of superintendent over \$9,500. Existing supervisory unions employing over 35 teachers and paying the superintendent of schools an annual salary of over \$4,500 \$9,500 shall not be regrouped unless the proposed regrouping shall have first been approved by a majority of the school committee members in the administrative units involved.'
