HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 414, L.D. 1310, Bill, "An Act to  
Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Public Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the Title, the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves passed by  
the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after  
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the said 90-day period will not terminate until  
after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the  
operation of departments and institutions will become due and  
payable on or immediately after July 1, 1965; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts  
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of  
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately  
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and  
safety; now, therefore, '

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end, the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the  
preamble, this Act, except as provided in section 30, shall take  
effect when approved.'
