IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officials of Androscoggin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Androscoggin County: County commissioners, \$2,000 \$2,400; chairman, \$2,600 \$3,000; clerk of courts, \$5,800 \$6,200; county attorney \$5,000 \$5,400; assistant county attorney, \$3,500 \$3,900; county treasurer, \$4,300 \$4,700; sheriff, \$5,500 \$5,900; register of deeds, \$5,800 \$6,200; judge of probate, \$5,000 \$5,400; register of probate, \$4,800 \$5,200.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Attorney General the sum of \$400 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$800 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 to provide for the increase in the salaries of the county attorney and assistant county attorney of Androscoggin County. The breakdown shall be as follows:
