STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Registration of Apothecary Stores.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., T. 32, § 2901, sub-4, additional. Section 2901 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 4, to read as follows:
- '4. Interest in store 51% or over. That at least 51% of the pharmacy is owned by a pharmacist or assistant pharmacist or, where the permit is sought for a pharmacy to be operated by a firm or corporation, that 51% or more of the interest in such firm or corporation is owned by a pharmacist registered under this chapter. This subsection shall not apply with respect to the interest held in any pharmacy operated on October 1, 1965.'
- Sec. 2. R. S., T. 32, § 2901, amended. Section 2901 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended by inserting after the 4th paragraph a new paragraph to read as follows:

'A permit may be issued to the executor or administrator of a deceased pharmacist to operate the decedent's store for a period not exceeding 12 months, for the purpose of settling the estate, providing that such store shall be conducted as otherwise required under this chapter.'
