SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 420, L. D. 1329, Bill, "An Act  
Establishing a State Board of Pesticides Control."

Amend said Bill, in that part designated "§1456" by striking  
out all of subsection 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'1. Study areas. Land and water areas in which a situation  
has developed, appears to be developing or should not be allowed to  
develop relative to the use of pesticides.'
