## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Liability of Railroads for Injuries to Employees by Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 35, § 1198, additional. Title 35 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1198, to read as follows:

'§ 1198. Liability of railroads

All railroad companies operating in the State shall be completely liable in cases where employees, who in the performance of their duties, are killed or injured at any public highway or road crossing by any highway vehicle.'
