STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Status of Investigators in Department of Attorney General.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 197, amended. The first sentence of section 197 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The Attorney General is authorized to employ in his office in addition to the officers named in section 196, investigators and additional clerks as the business of his office may demand, whose appointment and compensation shall be subject to the Personnel Law.'
