HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1005, L.D. 1338, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to Penalties for State House Parking  
Violations."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause,  
the following:

"Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, §1772, amended. Section 1772  
of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at  
the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

'Notwithstanding this subchapter or rules and regulations  
promulgated under this section, the Clerk of the House may  
issue an 8-hour parking permit to those persons who are  
invited to attend a session of either the Senate or House  
of Representatives, or both, in joint convention.'"

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning  
of the first line the underlined abbreviation and figure  
'Sec. 2.'
