COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1007, L.D. 1339, Bill, "An
Act Repealing Certain Exemptions from Sales Tax."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., T. 36, §1760, sub-§9, amended. Subsection 9
of section 1760 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended
to read as follows:

'9. Wood. ~~Coal, oil, wood~~ Wood ~~and all other fuels,~~
~~except gas and electricity,~~ when bought for cooking and heating
in homes, hotels and apartment houses, and other buildings
designed both for human habitation and sleeping.'"
