AN ACT Repealing Certain Exemptions from Sales Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 36, § 1760, sub-§ 9, repealed. Subsection 9 of section 1760 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is repealed as follows:

'9. Coal, oil and wood. Coal, oil, wood and all other fuels, except gas and electricity, when bought for cooking and heating in homes, hotels and apartment houses, and other buildings designed both for human habitation and sleeping.'

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This Act will produce to the State about \$930,000 per year.
