**AN ACT Providing for Compulsory Retirement of Teachers at Age 65.**

---

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S., T. 5, § 1121, sub-§ 1, ¶ D, additional.** Subsection 1 of section 1121 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph D to read as follows :

**'D. Any teacher who attains age 65 shall be retired forthwith notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary.'**
