AN ACT Relating to Training Qualifications for Practice of Hairdressing and Beauty Culture.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 1652, sub-§ 3, amended. Subsection 3 of section 1652 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'3. **Training.** Who has satisfactorily completed a course of instruction in a school of hairdressing and beauty culture approved by said board **and as an apprentice of 2,000 hours distributed over a period of at least 12 months**, or in lieu thereof has had a total experience in the practice of hairdressing and beauty culture or as an apprentice of ~~2,500~~ **3,400** hours distributed over a period of at least ~~18~~ **24** months;'
