#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Training Qualifications for Practice of Hairdressing and Beauty Culture.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 32, § 1652, sub-§ 3, amended. Subsection 3 of section 1652 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- '3. Training. Who has satisfactorily completed a course of instruction in a school of hairdressing and beauty culture approved by said board and as an apprentice of 2,000 hours distributed over a period of at least 12 months, or in lieu thereof has had a total experience in the practice of hairdressing and beauty culture or as an apprentice of 2,500 3,400 hours distributed over a period of at least 18 24 months;'
