AN ACT Regulating Fly Fishing in Certain Portion of Kennebec River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2553-A, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2553-A, to read as follows:

‘§ 2553-A. Fly fishing in Kennebec River

Kennebec River, downstream from Indian Pond dam in T1 R6, Somerset County to tidewater in Augusta, Kennebec County, shall be closed to all fishing except fly fishing for all fish from October 1st to October 31st of each year.’
