STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Sale of Unneeded Property of Department of Inland Fisheries and Game.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 1959, repealed. Section 1959 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is repealed, as follows:

'§ 1959. Sale of unneeded property

The Governor and Council on recommendation of the commissioner may sell and convey on behalf of the State the interests of the State in property taken or acquired by purchase under chapters 301 to 335 and deemed no longer necessary for the purposes hereof. The proceeds from such sales shall be eredited to the funds of the department.'
