STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire of Clerk of Courts and County Attorney in York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 801, amended. The first and 2nd sentences of section 801 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes are amended to read as follows:

'In all county offices there shall be allowed for clerk hire the amount authorized by the county commissioners of the various counties, except that the amounts authorized annually for the offices of clerk of courts and county attorney, in York County, shall not be less than \$10,000 and \$2,500 respectively. The salary of all clerks shall be determined by the county commissioners after receiving a recommendation from the county officer under whom such clerk is employed, except that in York County, the clerk of courts and county attorney shall determine the salaries of their respective clerks.'
