HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to S. P. 428, L. D. 1375, Bill,
"An Act Clarifying the Inland Fisheries and Game Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 12, a new
section, as follows:

"Sec. 12-A. R. S., T. 12, §2301, sub-§2-A, additional.
Section 2301 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by
adding a new subsection 2-A, to read as follows:

'2-A. Complimentary licenses for Maine residents in
Armed Forces. The commissioner is authorized to issue
complimentary fishing and hunting licenses to Maine residents
in the Armed Forces of the United States who are in Maine on
leave or furlough for a period of 2 weeks or less.' "
