HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1028, L. D. 1398, Bill,  
"An Act Exempting Textbooks Used in Schools of Higher  
Education from Sales Tax."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause  
the following:

"Sec. 1. R. S., T. 36, §1752, sub-§18-A, additional.  
Section 1752 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended  
by adding a new subsection 18-A, as follows:

'18-A. Textbook. "Textbook" means a book prepared,  
published, advertised and sold solely as a text for schools  
as defined in section 1760, subsection 16; and shall not  
include any book prepared, published, advertised or sold for  
general circulation, or any other publication, even though  
used as a text for schools.' "

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning  
of the first line the underlined abbreviation and figure  
'Sec. 2.'
