STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Providing Funds for Land Damages and Rights-of-Way for Maine-Quebec Highway.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Funds. There is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$50,000 to the County of Aroostook for the years 1965 and 1966 for the purpose of defraying expenses for land damages and the purchase of roads and rights-of-way to be incurred in the construction of a highway from Ashland, Maine to the Quebec border at a point near d'Aaquam, P. Q. Such appropriation shall not be available until the county commissioners of Aroostook County have laid out such highway as a public way and such appropriations shall not lapse until June 30, 1971.
