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**AN ACT Relating to Marking of Body Capacity of Vehicles Transporting  
Certain Materials.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 29, § 1756, additional.** Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1756, to read as follows:

**‘§ 1756. Markings on certain vehicles**

**No person who sells gravel, loam and other similar material shall transport such material to the purchaser thereof unless the vehicle in which the material is transported is plainly marked on either side of the vehicle’s body with the water-level capacity of the body of the vehicle in yards, with letters and numbers not less than 4 inches in height.’**
