COMMITTEE OF CONFERENCE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1037, L. D. 1408,
Bill, "An Act Relating to Payment by Dealers to Producers
for Milk Purchased."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the amending
clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"§2954-A. Payment by dealers to producers

Each dealer shall make payment to his producers of all sums
due for products purchased or received no later than 30 days from
the end of the calendar month in which delivery was made.

The license of any dealer who violates this section may be
suspended or revoked in accordance with Title 5, chapters 301 to
307."
