COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1039, L. D. 1413, Bill, "An Act Repealing Westbrook Sewerage District and Transferring Assets to City of Westbrook."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first paragraph of the referendum and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Referendum; effective date; certificate to Secretary of State. This Act shall take effect 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature, only for the purpose of permitting its submission to the qualified voters of the City of Westbrook at the next regular city election which is to be held on December 13, 1965 with an appropriate article being inserted in the call for said election. Tf a majority of the ballots cast at the special city election which is to be held on the first Monday in October, 1965 shall be in favor of the acceptance of an Act entitled "An Act Providing for a Mayor-Council Charter for the City of Westbrook" as passed by the 102nd Legislature and the total number of votes cast for or against the acceptance of said Act at the said special election equals or exceeds 20% of the total vote for all candidates for Governor in said city at the next previous gubernatorial election, then this Act shall be null and void and not submitted to a referendum.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the word "effective" in the first line of the 2nd paragraph from the end the words 'on January 1, 1966'
