HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1053, L.D. 1429, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Definition of Cord Under Weights and
Measures Law."

Amend said Bill, in section 1, by striking out all of
subparagraph (1) of paragraph A of subsection 1 and inserting
in place thereof the following:

'(1) A cord when used in connection with pulpwood,
slabs or edgings or manufacture of toothpicks, tongue depressers
and similar items shall mean the volume of wood contained in
a space 4 feet wide, 4 feet high and 8 feet long, or its
equivalent, when the wood is ranked and well stowed.'
