RESOLVE, Providing Increase in Retirement Allowance for Fred G. Smith of Ellsworth.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves do not become effective until 90 days after the Legislature adjourns unless passed as emergencies; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary to provide an increase in the allowance received by Fred G. Smith, a retired fish and game warden of advanced years to meet his minimum requirements; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Fred G. Smith, retirement allowance increased. Resolved: That the Maine State Retirement System shall increase the retirement of Fred G. Smith of Ellsworth, a retired fish and game warden, to an amount which will grant to him a retirement allowance of \$70 per month.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.
