RESOLVE, Providing for a Study of the State Personnel System.

Study of Personnel System. Resolved: That the Personnel Board be authorized to employ professional consultants to obtain the information necessary to determine whether changes are needed to improve the State Personnel Laws, special emphasis in the study to be given to the areas of classification and salary, present rules and regulations governing the hiring and discharging of state employees, and all phases of Personnel Department policies, functions and administration; and be it further

Resolved: That the 102nd Legislature directs that the State Personnel Board activate a State Advisory Council on Personnel, as provided for under the Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 592, subsection 9, the State Advisory Council on Personnel membership to be selected on advice of the Governor, and the President of the Senate and Speaker of the House of the 102nd Legislature, and that the State Advisory Council on Personnel act as liaison between the State Personnel Board and the professional consultants employed to carry out the purposes of this resolve.
