STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Advisory Committee of Health and Welfare.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 22, § 43, amended. Section 43 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Committee of Health and Welfare \$ 43.

An Advisory Committee of Health and Welfare in connection with the department, as heretofore established, shall consist of 15 members, 3 of whom shall represent the general public and shall be a Senator appointed by the President of the Senate and 2 Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House, 6 shall be persons interested in health or allied fields and 6 shall be persons interested in welfare or allied fields. The members shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice of the commissioner. Each member shall be appointed for a term of 3 years, and until his successor is appointed and duly gualified. The members of said committee shall serve without compensation, but may be allowed actual and necessary expenses for attendance at all meetings. The committee shall meet upon the call of the commissioner chairman or in his absence, upon the call of the vice-chairman. If the chairman fails to call a meeting, such meeting may be called at the request of a majority of the committee upon 10 days' written notice to the members of the committee. The committee shall meet at least twice quarterly in each calendar year; one such meeting shall be held annually in October, at which time a chairman and vice-chairman shall be elected from its members."

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 22, § 44, sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 44 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'1. Social problems. To make such investigation of the social problems of the State, with the aid of the departmental staff, as the commissioner committee may request desire;'
