STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Length of Certain Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 244, amended. The 4th paragraph from the end of section 244 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'No motor vehicle, or combination of motor vehicle and trailer or semitrailer, except fire department vehicles, shall exceed in length 55 60 feet over all including all structural parts thereof, permanent or temporary, and any load carried thereon or therein.
