AN ACT Relating to Use of Moneys Received from the Potato Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Bargaining agents. A sum which shall for 2 years equal at least \$15,000 annually of the money collected under the Revised Statutes, Title 36, chapter 709, shall be used and applied for the purpose of bargaining with the processors of potatoes and other merchandisers for better potato prices and marketing conditions. The Maine Potato Commission shall appoint a bargaining committee consisting of 7 members, to carry out the purpose of this Act.
