SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 491, L. D. 1456, Bill, "An Act Relating to Cualifications for Practice of Hairdressing and Beauty Culture."

Amend said Bill, by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following Title: 'AN ACT Relating to Membership on the State Board of Hairdressers.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"Sec. 1. R. S., T. 32, \$1601, amended. The first paragraph of section 1601 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The State Board of Hairdressers, as heretofore established and in this chapter designated as the "board", shall consist of $\frac{1}{2}$ members who shall be citizens of this State, $\frac{3}{2}$ of whom shall have been engaged in the practice of hairdressing for at least 5 years immediately prior to their appointment. The tenure of each board member shall be for 2 years.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 32, \$1601, amended. The first sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 1601 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The 3 5 members of the board who are hairdressers shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Council.'"
