AN ACT Authorizing Town of Island Falls to Construct Certain Road.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, access to inland waters is extremely important to encourage Maine's recreational industry; and

Whereas, roads over which motor vehicles can travel with safety to such inland waters is essential; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary to permit the Town of Island Falls to aid in the construction of part of the Pond Road, so-called, to permit safe access to Pleasant Lake; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Certain road to be constructed. The Town of Island Falls, Aroostook County, is authorized to expend \$2,132 of its state aid road construction moneys to aid in constructing part of the Pond Road, so-called, located in the Town of Dyer Brook. Such construction shall begin approximately 3 miles northwest from Route #2 and continue in a northwesterly direction to the town line with T4, R3.

Sec. 2. Limitation. The authorization, given to the Town of Island Falls

under this Act, to expend its state aid road construction moneys, shall be void after December 31, 1967.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
