IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT to Provide Adjustments in Pensions Being Paid to Members of the Police and Fire Departments of the City of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1927, c. 75, § 4, amended. Section 4 of chapter 75 of the private and special laws of 1927, as repealed and replaced by chapter 121 of the private and special laws of 1963, is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 4. Ordinance for adjusting pensions. The City of Portland is further authorized to provide by ordinance for adjusting pensions of members of the police and fire departments, and in order to carry into effect such adjustment, said City of Portland is authorized to pay to such members of the police and fire departments, as are on the pension rolls, an added amount so that a pension of not more than ~~\$4~~ \$6 per day shall be paid. This section shall not apply to call members of the fire department now on the pension rolls nor to members of the police or fire departments now on the pension rolls who are now receiving a pension greater than they would receive under this section.'
