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AN ACT Relating to Larceny of Rented Motor Vehicles.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 17, § 2113, additional.** Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2113 to read as follows:

‘§ 2113. Larceny

Any person to whom a motor vehicle, semitrailer or trailer is delivered on a rental or lease basis under any agreement in writing providing for its return to a particular place at a particular time who refuses or willfully neglects to return such vehicle or trailer, after the expiration of the time stated in a notice in writing proved to have been duly mailed by registered mail addressed to the last known address of the person who rented or leased the motor vehicle, semitrailer or trailer is guilty of larceny.’
