STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Appropriating Moneys for Maine Civil War Commission.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves passed by the Legislature do not become effective until 90 day safter adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the 90-day period will not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

Whereas, the commemorative activities and functions planned by the Maine Civil War Commission during this period will require funds for their accomplishment; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated to the Maine Civil War Commission from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$5,000 for the expenses and operation of the commission. Any unexpended balance shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1967.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
