COMMITTEE AMENDA.NT "A" to S. P. 513, L. D. 1485, Bill, "An Act Relating to Mental Examination and Observation of Persons Accused of Crime."

Amend said Bill in the 12th line by inserting after the underlined words and punctuation "<u>or both</u>," the underlined words and punctuation '<u>or by one psychiatrist and one or more clinical</u> <u>psychologists</u>,'

Further amend said Bill in the 16th line by inserting after the underlined word "<u>Corrections</u>" the underlined words '<u>or by other</u> properly qualified psychiatrists or psychologists'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end of the next to the last paragraph the following underlined sentence: '<u>A report</u> of the results of the observation shall be forwarded promptly to the court by the commissioner.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined paragraph, except the single quotation mark.
