SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1093, L. D. 1489, Bill, "An Act
to Clarify the Motor Vehicle Laws."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by adding at the end of the
first paragraph the following underlined sentence: 'No
manufacturer or dealer or holder of a transporter registration
certificate shall attach to the rear plate holder of a house
trailer or mobile home any temporary registration plate unless
the operator of the vehicle hauling the trailer has in his
possession the written certificate from the tax collector
required by section 336, subsection 5.'
