RESOLVE, Authorizing Construction of Bridge to Quigg Island in Stevens Pond, Waldo County.

Construction of bridge to Quigg Island; authorized. Resolved: That J. Lawrence Robbins, Jenness L. Robbins and James L. Robbins, their heirs or assigns, are authorized to construct and maintain a bridge from Quigg Island, situated in Stevens Pond, in the Town of Liberty, Waldo County, to their existing right-of-way from the shore of said pond to Route 173; the exact location of said bridge to be determined by the aforesaid J. Lawrence Robbins, Jenness L. Robbins and James L. Robbins and to be constructed in such a manner as not to interfere with the passage of watercraft beneath said bridge.
