IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Expenses of Members of Liquor Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 53, amended. Section 53 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'§ 53. Salaries and expenses

The salary of the chairman of the commission shall be \$8,500 per year and the salary of each of the other members shall be \$5,625 per year, and in addition each member shall be allowed his reasonable expense actual expenses incurred in the performance of his official duties while away from home. Such expense shall not include travel between his place of residence and the commission office, or board and lodging in the city or town where such office is located or in the City of Augusta.
