STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Provide for Underwater Weed Cutter.

Underwater weed cutter; appropriation. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$2,000 to the State Park and Recreation Commission to purchase an underwater weed cutter to be used to eliminate aquatic growth in the lakes and ponds of Maine; and be it further

Resolved: That since any measures taken to modify the aquatic environment will have an effect upon the fish and wildlife dependent upon that environment, any program to eliminate aquatic plants resulting from this resolve must have the approval of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game.
