AN ACT Relating to Hunting Buck Deer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., T. 12, § 2353, amended. Section 2353 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by inserting before the 2nd paragraph from the end, a new paragraph, as follows :

'During the first 15 days of the open season on deer in all zones it shall be lawful to kill buck deer only.'
