HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 526,
L. D. 1504, Bill, "An Act Revising the Minimum Wage Law."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the underlined
3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th lines from the end and inserting in place
thereof the following:

"at a rate no less than \$1.25 per hour. The overtime provision
of this section shall not apply to the canning, processing,
preserving, freezing, drying, marketing, storing, packing for
shipment or distribution of herring as sardines, of perishable
foods, of agricultural produce, and meat and fish products, nor
to the canning of perishable goods, nor to nursing homes and
hospitals."
