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**RESOLVE, to Reimburse Mrs. Hazel Costigan, of Milford, for Well Damage.**

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**Mrs. Hazel Costigan; reimbursed. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,500 to be paid to Mrs. Hazel Costigan of Milford, for damage to her well caused by highway construction on Route 2.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Chemical examination of Mrs. Costigan's well shows a high content of salt. Mrs. Costigan is almost bedridden with arthritis and a bad heart. The Highway Commission took a piece of her land for highway construction and the snow from the highway was then piled on top of her well. The water is now unsafe for domestic consumption.
