## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 102nd LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1104, L. D. 1508, Bill, "An Act Relating to Inspection of Certain Farm Trucks.

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, farming is one of Maine's essential industries and the following legislation is vitally necessary to prevent undue hardship on many of Maine's farmers; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the 3rd underlined sentence from the end which reads as follows:

"The Chief of the State Police shall issue a certificate of special color to satisfy this purpose."

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
