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**AN ACT Relating to Inspection of Certain Farm Trucks.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 29, § 2122, amended.** Section 2122 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

'This section shall not apply to farm trucks as defined in section 246 which are limited in operation to within a radius of 15 miles from the main entrance of the farm where such a vehicle is customarily kept, providing the running gear, brakes and lights conform to this section. The Chief of the State Police shall issue a certificate of special color to satisfy this purpose. Such trucks shall have the name of the town in which the excise tax has been paid printed in letters not less than 4 inches in height on the door on the left side of the cab of the truck. Section 1369 shall not apply to regulations promulgated under this paragraph with respect to glazing of farm trucks.'
