HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 530, L.D. 1509, Bill "An Act  
Providing for Cost of Living Plan for Retired State  
Employees, Teachers and Participating District Employees,  
or Beneficiaries of Same."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last under-  
lined line of paragraph B of subsection 7 of section 2 and  
inserting in place thereof the following: 'funds to which  
members make contributions.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of that  
part designated subparagraph (1) of paragraph B of subsection  
7 of section 2, which reads as follows:

"(1) Except that any member who, at the effective  
date of this Act, is required to contribute to the  
Members' Contribution Fund at a rate higher than  
5% shall be exempted from making contributions to  
the Retirement Allowance Adjustment Fund but shall  
be entitled to such benefits that may accrue."
