AN ACT Relating to Taking of Alewives in Little River and Boyden Stream.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Taking of alewives in Little River and Boyden Stream. Exclusive rights to the taking of alewives from Little River and Boyden Stream, the outlet stream from Boyden's Lake running into Passamaquoddy Bay in the Town of Perry, Washington County, shall be optional with the Town of Perry.
