SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1108, L. D. 1514, Bill, "An Act
Providing for Adequate Fishways in Dams."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of subsection 1 of section
1 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'1. Petition by citizens. Whenever he shall be petitioned by
200 citizens of a municipality or municipalities in which such a
dam or artificial obstruction either exists or is adjacent to a
municipality in which such dam or artificial obstruction exists;'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end of the 2nd
paragraph of section 2, before the period, the following: 'and
said notice shall be sent by registered mail to the owner or owners
of such dam or artificial obstruction, if same shall be known or
determined by the records of the municipality in which the dam or
obstruction is located'
